Agency Booked Care

Last-minute & planned care requests with our nannies

This option allows you to access child care staffed by a vetted employee from Philadelphia Nanny Network. Each nanny undergoes our rigorous vetting process, with thorough screenings and background checks, to ensure safety and reliability.

The nanny will work the hours you need and engage your child in enriching activities throughout the day while following your specific directions. Because this service is part of your employer's benefit program, you don't pay the nanny directly at the end of the shift like you would with a typical babysitter. Instead, your employer will cover most of the cost of the nanny's services, providing you with peace of mind and convenience. There will be a \$7 per hour co-pay.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the minimum hour requirement for requests?

There is a 4 hour minimum for a care request. A nanny can be booked for fewer hours, though 4 hours will be deducted from your benefit hours.

What ages do you care for?

Acceptable ages of the children for care are 6 weeks and older, and up to 4 children per nanny.

If I like the nanny, can I hire her outside of my benefit?

While we know you'll love our nannies, hiring them outside the agency is not permitted. Our nannies cannot be shared with other parents either. You can, however, continue to use our services directly. You're set up in our system making it easy to submit a request for additional care outside of the benefit, though you would be responsible for the agency fee which includes the nanny pay.

POLICIES TO KNOW

CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellations made after 5PM but before midnight the day prior to care will reduce the available benefit hours by 4 hours. If you cancel 3 hours or less before the start of care on the same day of care, your benefit hours will be reduced by the full number of hours booked. If the nanny can be reassigned to another family for a different shift, the cancellation penalty will be waived.

NON-BACKUP CARE THROUGH PNN

If you would like to have the nanny care for children outside of benefit parameters, it must be arranged through Philadelphia Nanny Network. Nannies cannot be solicited to work directly for parents, unless it is arranged through Philadelphia Nanny Network.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFO

There is no swimming, driving or dispensing of medication by any caregiver, at any time. Parents are responsible for providing the nanny with emergency contact numbers and all the pertinent information needed to successfully care for the children.

ILLNESS

Our nannies can provide care for mildly ill children such as those with a low grade fever or sniffles. We request that you provide the symptoms the child is experiencing when placing the request.

Out of an abundance of caution, we do not care for children with highly contagious diseases in order to limit the spread to others. While this list is not exhaustive, this is an example of those that would prevent us from providing care: Hand Foot Mouth, Covid, Pink Eye, the Flu, etc.

If your child begins showing symptoms of illness after care is booked, please update your care request.



HOW TO USE YOUR BENEFIT

- Enroll with Philadelphia Nanny Network
 - Complete an application about your children, pets, and care needs
 - Sign a Services Agreement
 - No registration payment is required, this is an employee benefit!
- Save the Care Request link
 - Bookmark the link on your computer toolbar or phone for easy access. You will receive the link when you enroll.
- Submit a care request
 - When you need care, just fill out the Care Request Form
 - Our Staffing Team will assign a nanny
- Receive a confirmation email
 - You will get an email once the request is booked
- Nanny introduction
 - The assigned nanny will contact you as an introduction.
- Nanny arrives
 - The nanny arrives at your home, and you can go to work!
